


Charming Tadoba...

Road map

5 nts. 6 days.

- Day 1 ● Departure from Pune or Mumbai - :
In the evening, board a train from Pune or Mumbai for Nagpur.
Overnight Journey.
- Day 2 ● Nagpur - Tadoba :
Arrive at Nagpur in the morning. Have breakfast and proceed to Tadoba.
In the afternoon, have a First Jungle Safari.
Overnight Stay at Tadoba.
- Day 3 ● Tadoba :
Early in the morning, go for Second Jungle Safari. Take rest.
In the afternoon, go for Third Jungle Safari.
Overnight Stay at Tadoba.
- Day 4 ● Tadoba :
Early in the morning, go for Forth Jungle Safari. Take rest.
In the evening, Go for a walk in nearby area.
Overnight Stay at Tadoba.
- Day 5 ● Tadoba - Nagpur :
Early in the morning, visit jungle for the 5th time. After breakfast, proceed to Nagpur. Board a train to Pune or Mumbai.

- Day 6 ● Arrival at Pune or Mumbai :
Reach Pune or Mumbai in the morning.

Tadoba National Park is the oldest and largest national park in Maharashtra located in the Chandrapur District of Maharashtra. The name 'Tadoba' is the name of the God "Tadoba" or "Taru", praised by the tribal people who live in the dense forests of the Tadoba and Andhari region, while the Andhari River that meanders through the forest gives the 'Andhari' name.

Tadoba National Park is just 40 kms. from Chandrapur City. Latitudes and longitudes are 20°10' North and 79°24' East. Tadoba Andheri Reserve lies in the area of 625.4 square kilometers (241.5 sq mi). This includes Tadoba National Park, created in 1955 with an area of 116.55 square kilometers (45.00 sq mi) and Andhari Wildlife Sanctuary created in 1986 with an area of 508.85 square kilometers (196.47 sq mi). The Reserve also includes 32.51 square kilometers (12.55 sq mi) Protected Forest and 14.93 square kilometers (5.76 sq mi) 'Other areas'. Densely forested hills form the northern and western boundary of the Tiger Reserve. Tadoba lake which acts as a buffer between the park's forest and the extensive farmland which extends up to Irai water reservoir. This lake is a perennial water source which offers good habitat for crocodiles to thrive. Other wetland areas within the reserve include the Kolsa lake and Andhari river.

This park has a large biodiversity. The trees commonly found here are Ain, Dhauda, Haldu, Salai, Semal, Tendu, Beheda, Hirda, Karaya gum, Mahua. Axlewood *Anogeissus latifolia* is a fire-resistant species growing here. Palas or Flame of the Forest *Butea monosperma* adds vibrant colour to the forest. Black plum trees grow in the riparian habitat around the lake. At the waterhole at Panchadhara, huge arjun trees are seen.

Aside from around 65 of the keystone species Bengal tiger, Tadoba Tiger Reserve is home to other mammals, including Indian Leopards, Sloth Bears, Indian Gaur, Blue Bull, Sambar Deer, Spotted Deer, Barking Deer. Tadoba Lake sustains the Marsh Crocodile, which were once common all over Maharashtra.

The lake is an ornithologist's paradise with a wide diversity of water birds, and raptors. 195 species of birds have been recorded, including three endangered species. The Grey-headed fish eagle, the Crested Serpent Eagle, and the Changeable Hawk-Eagle are some of the raptors. Other interesting species include the Orange-headed Thrush, Indian Pitta, Crested Treeswift, Stone Curlew, Honey Buzzard, Paradise Flycatcher, Bronze-winged Jacana and Lesser Golden backed Woodpecker, Warblers and the black-naped blue flycatcher exist here and the call of the peacock may often be heard.

The park lies within the tropical monsoon climatic zone, characterized by well-defined winters, summers and rains. Temperature as low as 8.2 °C and as high as 44 °C have been recorded. Average rainfall is 1,273 millimeters, most of which



Info :

Located in the Chandrapur district of Maharashtra, the Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve is one of India's prominent reserves. Its tropical dry deciduous forest ecosystem. Tadoba became one of India's earliest national parks when it was so notified in 1955, the same year as Kanha. In 1993, Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Reserve (TATR), finally settled at 622.87 sq. kms. Moharli and Khutwanda gates are 170 kms. from Nagpur while Kolara nad Navegaon gates are 100 kms. from Nagpur.




Day - 2

Tadoba



Early in the morning, continue our journey of tracking 'The Big Cat' with Second Jungle Safari. Come back to resort at 11:00 hrs. Take Rest.


