



Into the Wild: Kanha



Kanha National Park is a tiger reserve in the Mandla and Balaghat districts of Madhya Pradesh, India. In the 1930s, the Kanha area was split into two sanctuaries – Hallon, 250 km², and Banjar, 300 km². Kanha National Park was officially created on 1 June 1955. Today it covers 940 km². With its surrounding buffer zone of 1,067 km² and the adjoining 110 km² Phen Sanctuary, it forms the Kanha Tiger Reserve. Kanha's landmark achievement is saving the rare hard-ground barasingha, or swamp deer, from near extinction. Strict conservation programs for the park's flora and fauna make it one of the largest and best-maintained national parks in Central India. The park has a thriving population of Royal Bengal tigers, leopards, sloth bears, barasingha, and Indian wild dogs. The lush sal and bamboo forests, open grassy meadows, and deep ravines of Kanha inspired Rudyard Kipling's *The Jungle Book*. Kanha is divided into four tourism zones – Kisli, Kanha, Mukki, and Sarhi – each offering a different landscape and wildlife experience. Early morning safaris are magical here, with mist over the meadows and barasingha herds grazing at sunrise. The park is also a birdwatcher's paradise, home to over 300 species including crested serpent eagles, storks, and Malabar pied hornbills. Conservation efforts at Kanha have become a global model, especially the successful relocation of barasingha and tiger protection programs. With its dramatic landscapes and high sighting chances, Kanha truly earns its title as the "land of the tiger".

Getting there: Jabalpur, 175 kms away, has the nearest airport with flights to Mumbai, Delhi, and other major cities. Mandla, just 70 km from Kanha, is well connected and has tourist taxi services from Jabalpur to the park. From Jabalpur, drive via Mandla and Nainpur – with an overnight stop if needed – then take the diversion at Bamhni. Mandla, Nainpur, and Seoni all have clubs, internet cafes, guides, churches, and temples. Kanha has three entry gates. Kisli Gate is best accessed from Jabalpur and enters near Khatia village inside the buffer. The other two are Mukki Gate and the newer Serai Gate. Jabalpur remains the most convenient base.

Climate: Kanha lies in a tropical monsoon zone with distinct winters, summers, and rains. Temperatures range from 5.2°C to 44°C. Average rainfall is 152 cm, mostly during the monsoon. Some cyclonic rains also occur between November and February.

Tour Itinerary for 5 Nights / 6 Days.

Day 1 : Pune - Mumbai - Jabalpur :-

We will start our journey from Pune in the morning by Deccan Queen or Pragati Exp. to reach Mumbai (CST). In the afternoon we will board Garibrath Exp. for Jabalpur at 13:30 hrs.

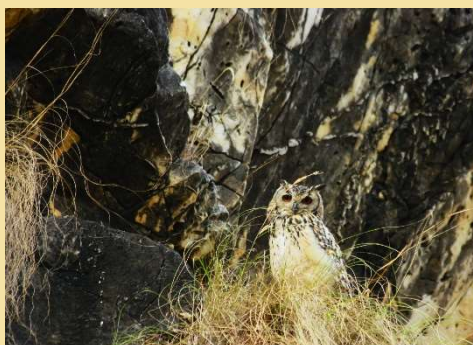
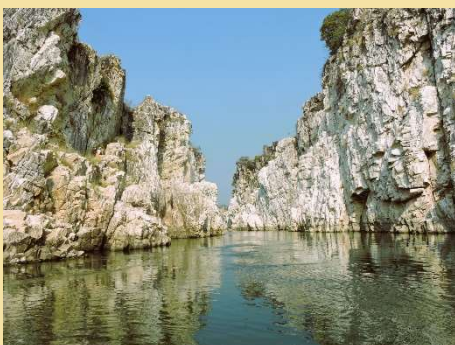
Overnight Journey. (No Food Included)

Day 2 : Jabalpur - Kanha via Bhedaghat :- (175 kms. 4 hrs.)

We will reach Jabalpur Railway Station at 06:00 hrs. From the station, we will drive straight to Bhedaghat, just 20 kms out, where the Narmada River slices through gleaming white marble gorges. A calm 30-45 minutes boat ride will bring us right up to those towering marble walls mirrored in the water. Post breakfast, we will head to the star attraction – the thundering Dhuadhar Falls. Millions of litres of water crash down in a fierce drop, throwing up a fine mist that looks like smoke drifting through the air.

By around 11:00 hrs., we will set off for **Kanha National Park**. Expect to reach by 15:00 hrs., check into the resort, and take a breather. As evening sets in, we will walk a nature trail along Kanha's buffer zone. It's the perfect warm-up to the jungle – bird calls, fresh pugmarks, and that electric feeling of being in tiger territory. We will be back at the resort by 19:00 hrs., exhausted but still charged up from the day.

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Day 3 : Kanha :-

Early morning, we will enter Kanha National Park by gypsy for our **First Jungle Safari**. Glide past endless Sal forests, grassy meadows, and watering holes that attract spotted deer, sambar, and the rare hard-ground barasingha – Kanha's pride. Keep your eyes peeled: leopards, wild dogs, sloth bears, and if we are lucky, the elusive tiger. The forest echoes with peacock calls, hornbills, and eagle cries. We will return to the resort around 11:00 hrs. for some well-earned rest. After lunch, we depart for our **Second Jungle Safari**. Afternoon safaris paint the jungle gold. The light, the silence, the sudden rustle in the bushes – every moment keeps you alert. Return to resort by evening with stories of pugmarks and sightings.

Night stay at the Resort in Kanha. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 4 : Kanha :-

At dawn, we will head out in the gypsy for our **Third Jungle Safari**. It's another shot at spotting tigers and soaking up Kanha's wild pulse. We will be back at the resort by around 11:00 hrs. – use the time to relax. Post lunch, we will roll out for our **Fourth Jungle Safari**. The late-afternoon sun turns the jungle amber, and animals usually become more active before nightfall. We will return by 18:30 hrs. and swap stories and best shots from all four rides over tea.

Night stay at the Resort in Kanha. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)



Day 5 : Kanha - Jabalpur :- (150 kms. 4 hrs.)

At first light, we will head out in the gypsy for our **Fifth and last jungle safari**. One final opportunity to spot the tiger or any luck Kanha has waiting for us. We will be back at the resort by 11:00 hrs. to get ready with your bags. After lunch: Around 13:00 hrs., we will drive you to Jabalpur Railway Station for the 19:30 hrs. Garibrath Express to Mumbai. It's time to bid farewell to the forest, carrying back memories of stripes, calls, and winding jungle trails. **Overnight Journey. (Breakfast and Lunch Included.)**



Day 6 : Mumbai - Pune

Arrive at Mumbai (CST) at 12:20 hrs. After lunch we will board the train to reach Pune in the evening. **(No Food Included)**
