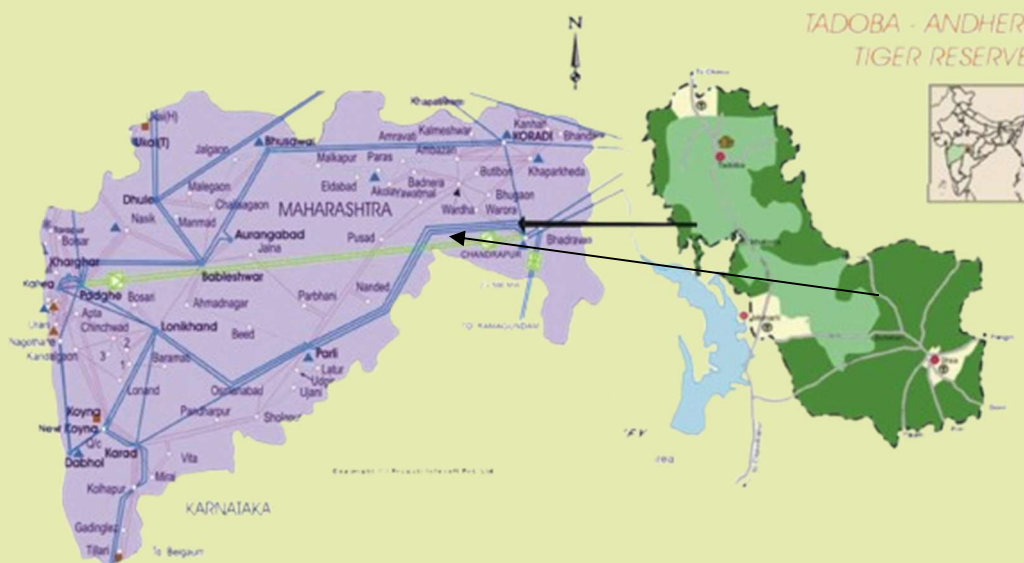


Tadoba - Find Your Wild Side

Tadoba Andhari Tiger Reserve – the oldest and biggest tiger reserve in Maharashtra. It's located in Chandrapur district. The name 'Tadoba' comes from God Tadoba, also called Taru, who is worshipped by local tribal people living in these dense forests. 'Andhari' is named after the Andhari River that flows through the jungle. The reserve is just 40 km from Chandrapur city.

Total area is 625.4 km². This includes Tadoba National Park, started in 1955 with 116.55 km², and Andhari Wildlife Sanctuary, started in 1986 with 508.85 km². There are also 32.51 km² of protected forest and 14.93 km² of other land. Thick forest hills cover the north and west side of the reserve. Tadoba Lake is a big water source that stays full all year. It works like a natural wall between the forest and nearby farms up to Irai dam. Crocodiles love this lake. Kolsa Lake and Andhari River are the other main water spots here. The forest is rich and green. You'll find trees like Ain, Dhauda, Haldu, Salai, Semal, Tendu, Beheda, Hirda, Mahua and Karaya. Axlewood trees can survive forest fires. In summer, Palas or Flame of the Forest trees make the jungle look bright orange. Black plum trees grow near the lake, and huge Arjun trees stand at Panchadhara waterhole. For wildlife, Tadoba has around 65 Bengal tigers – that's why it's called 'Land of Tigers'. Apart from tigers, you can spot Indian leopards, sloth bears, Indian gaur, blue bull, sambar deer, spotted deer and barking deer. Marsh crocodiles are easily seen in Tadoba Lake. Bird lovers will enjoy it too. 195 types of birds live here, including 3 endangered ones. You can see Grey-headed Fish Eagle, Crested Serpent Eagle, Changeable Hawk-Eagle, Orange-headed Thrush, Indian Pitta, Paradise Flycatcher and many more. Peacock calls echo through the jungle all day.

Weather in Tadoba has 3 clear seasons – hot summer, cool winter and monsoon rain. Temperature goes from 8.2°C in winter to 44°C in summer. Average rainfall is 1273 mm, mostly during monsoon. Sometimes we also get rain from cyclones between November and February.

Tour Itinerary for 5 Nights / 6 Days.

Day 1 : Pune - Nagpur :-

Our trip starts from Pune Rly. Stn. in the evening. We will board the Garibrath Express to reach Nagpur at 17:30 hrs. **Overnight Journey. (No Food Included)**

Day 2 : Nagpur - Tadoba :- (110 kms. 2 hrs.)

We will arrive at Nagpur Railway Station by 09:30 hrs. After breakfast, we will head out to **Tadoba National Park** around 10:30 hrs. We should get to Tadoba by 12:30 hrs., check into our hotel, and enjoy some lunch.

Post-lunch, it's time for our **First Jungle Safari** in a gypsy! Tadoba is known for its tigers, and we will do our best to catch a glimpse of the king of the jungle and leopards. Besides these predators, we might spot spotted deer, sambar deer, blue bulls, wild boars, Indian Gaur and jackals. You will love to watch the vultures, eagles, peacocks, owls, and various flycatchers that add to the jungle's charm. We'll head back to the resort around 18:30 hrs. Don't forget to share your safari tales and photos with everyone over a cup of tea.

Day 3 : Tadoba :-

Tomorrow morning, we're off for our **Second Jungle Safari** in a Gypsy! It's another chance to catch a glimpse of tigers and soak in the wild atmosphere of Tadoba. We will swing by Tadoba Lake, right in the heart of the jungle, where you might spot Sambar deer hanging out by the water. Plus, keep an eye out for crocodiles lounging on the banks! We will be back at the Resort by 11:00 hrs., so don't forget to share your awesome experiences and photos with everyone! After lunch, we will gear up for our **Third Jungle Safari**, returning around 18:30 hrs. We will dive deeper into the lush forest and hopefully see even more amazing wildlife.

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Day 4 : Tadoba :-

As the sun rises, we hop into the gypsy for our **Fourth Jungle Safari**, feeling the excitement as the wild awakens. If luck is on our side, we might see the magnificent tiger or leopard again. The woods are bustling with noise: peacocks are vocalizing, hornbills are beating their powerful wings, and eagles are shrieking above. We will explore some other parts of Tadoba, hoping to spot some birds and mammals.

After lunch, we will take it easy and unwind. Later in the afternoon, we will go for a nature walk near our resort. We will check out some amazing trees, insects, and birds. Plus, we will have a great time with fun activities at the resort like swimming and badminton.

Day 5 : Tadoba - Nagpur :- (110 kms. 2 hrs.)

At dawn, we jumped into the gypsy for our **Fifth and last Safari**—a final chance to see a tiger or perhaps some surprising sights that Tadoba had waiting for us. By 11:00 hrs., we returned to the resort, filled with fresh, unforgettable memories of the wilderness. After lunch, around 13:00 hrs., it would be time to go to Nagpur Rly. Stn. and catch the Garibrath Express at 18:00 hrs., beginning our trip back to Pune..

Experiencing nature up close is always exhilarating, and capturing those memorable moments together is truly special!
