



Wild Trails at Bandhavgarh

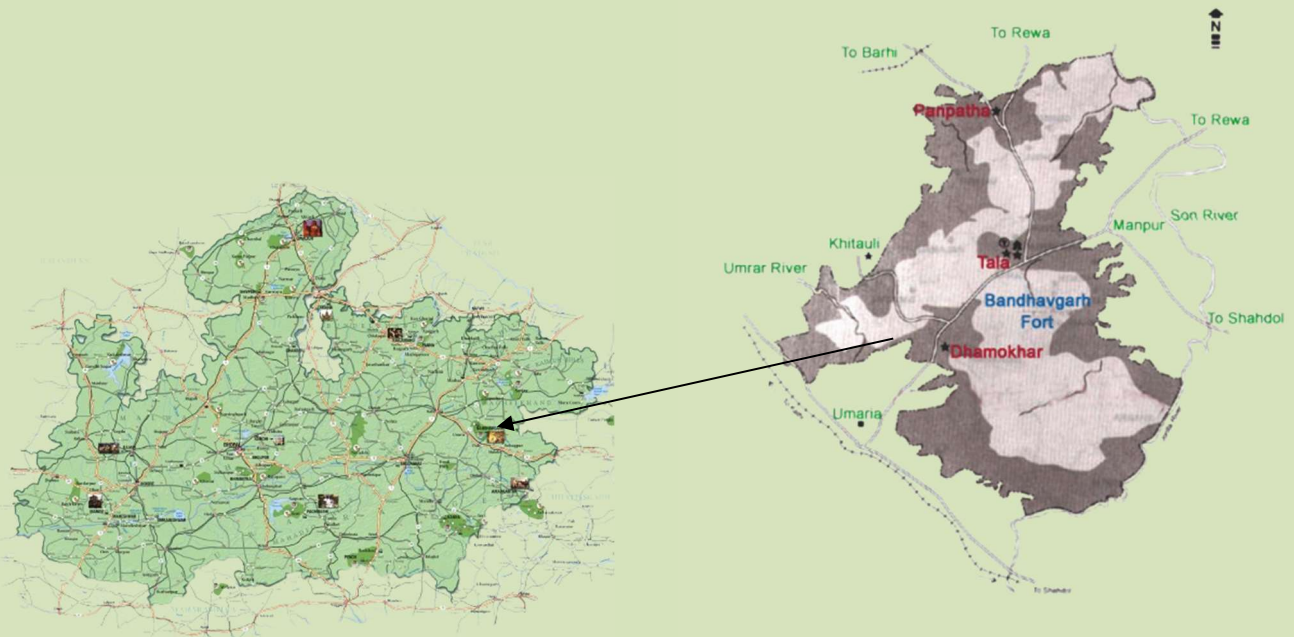


Bandhavgarh National Park, nestled in the Umaria district of Madhya Pradesh, is one of India's most celebrated wildlife sanctuaries, renowned for its rich biodiversity and fascinating history. The park derives its evocative name from the imposing Bandhavgarh hill, which legend says was gifted by Lord Rama to his brother Lakshmana to keep watch over Lanka. This mythological connection gave rise to the Sanskrit name *Bandhavgarh*, meaning "Brother's Fort." Declared a national park in 1968 with an initial core area of 105 km², Bandhavgarh later expanded to include the ranges of Khitauli, Magdhi, and Kallawah in 1982, forming a buffer zone of 437 km². Its inclusion under Project Tiger in 1972 further underscored its importance in India's conservation efforts.

The park is celebrated for having one of the highest tiger densities in the country, making it a premier destination for wildlife enthusiasts. Alongside its thriving tiger population, Bandhavgarh shelters leopards, numerous species of deer, and a wide variety of birds, all thriving in its diverse habitats. The park also holds a unique place in history as the site where Maharaja Martand Singh of Rewa captured the famous white tiger, Mohan, in 1951—a specimen now preserved in the Rewa palace. This event cemented Bandhavgarh's reputation as a land of rare and majestic wildlife.

Geographically, the park lies on the northeastern edge of Madhya Pradesh, within the northern flanks of the Satpura range. Its terrain is a dramatic blend of rocky hills, cliffs, and lush valleys, with Bandhavgarh Hill rising to 811 meters above sea level as its centerpiece. Numerous streams, including the Umrar, Johilla, and Charanganga, weave through the park, eventually feeding into the Son River, a vital tributary of the Ganges. The valleys often open into swampy meadows known locally as *bohera*, creating a mosaic of landscapes that support a wide range of flora and fauna. The geology is dominated by soft feldspathic sandstone and quartzite, with sandy to sandy-loam soils that nurture the park's vegetation.

Bandhavgarh's climate falls within the tropical monsoon zone, marked by distinct seasons. Winters can be crisp, with temperatures dipping to 2.2 °C, while summers are hot, soaring up to 44 °C. The monsoon brings an average rainfall of 1,173 millimeters, replenishing the streams and forests, while occasional cyclonic showers between November and February add to the park's lushness. This dynamic climate, combined with its varied terrain, makes Bandhavgarh not only a haven for wildlife but also a landscape of striking natural beauty, steeped in myth, history, and ecological significance.

Tour Itinerary for 5 Nights / 6 Days.

Day 1 : Pune - Mumbai - Jabalpur :-

We will start our journey from Pune in the morning by Deccan Queen or Pragati Exp. to reach Mumbai (CST). In the afternoon we will board Garibrath Exp. for Jabalpur at 13:30 hrs.

Overnight Journey. (No Food Included)

Day 2 : Jabalpur - Bandhavgarh via Bhedaghat :- (225 kms. 5 hrs.)

We will arrive at Jabalpur Railway Station at 06:00 hrs. From there, we will head straight to **Bhedaghat**, where the Narmada River carves its way through stunning white marble rocks, just 20 km from Jabalpur city. A peaceful 30-45 minutes boat ride on the river will give us close-up views of the marble cliffs reflecting in the water. After breakfast, we will visit the crown jewel of the region – the mighty **Dhuadhar Falls**. Watch millions of gallons of water plunge down with a roar, creating a misty "smoke-like" spray that gives the falls their name.

Around 11:00 hrs, we will begin our drive to **Bandhavgarh National Park**. We will reach by 15:00 hrs., check into the hotel, and take some time to unwind. In the evening, we will explore a nature trail through the buffer zone of Bandhavgarh National Park. It's the perfect introduction to the jungle – the sounds, the tracks, the quiet thrill of being in tiger country. We'll return to the resort by 19:00 hrs., tired but buzzing from the day.

Day 3 : Bandhavgarh :-

We will kick off the day early with our **First Jungle Safari** by gypsy. This is our best shot at spotting the king of the jungle – the majestic tiger. If we are lucky, we might also sight leopards, spotted deer, blue bull, jackal, wild boar, and sambar deer. The jungle's just as stunning above ground – peacocks displaying their feathers, vultures and eagles circling high, plus owls and flycatchers darting through the trees. We will return to the resort around 11:00 hrs. for some well-earned rest. After lunch, we head out for our **Second Jungle Safari**. The forest feels completely different in the afternoon light. Back at the resort by 18:30 hrs., we will swap stories, share photos, and relive every sighting over chai.

Night stay at Resort in Bandhavgarh. (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner Included)

Day 4 : Bandhavgarh :-

Early morning, we will head out for our **Third Jungle Safari** by gypsy. One more chance to track tigers and soak in the raw energy of Bandhavgarh. We will return to the resort around 11:00 hrs. – rest up. After lunch, it's time for our **Fourth Jungle Safari**. The afternoon light makes the forest look golden, and wildlife often steps out before dusk. Back by 18:30 hrs., we will gather to share our best stories and photos from all four rides.

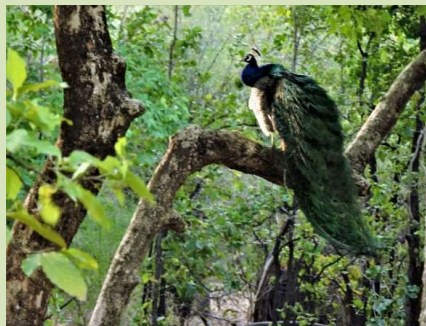

Day 5 : Bandhavgarh - Jabalpur :- (170 kms. 4 hrs.)

Early morning, we will set out for our **Fifth and final Jungle Safari** by gypsy. Last chance to catch a glimpse of the tiger or any hidden surprises Bandhavgarh has in store. We will return to the resort around 11:00 hrs. to freshen up and pack. After lunch, at around 13:00 hrs., we will transfer you to Jabalpur Railway Station to board the Garibrath Express for Mumbai at 19:30 hrs. Say goodbye to the jungle, with memories of stripes, calls, and forest trails.

Arrive at Mumbai (CST) at 12:20 pm. After lunch we will board the train to reach Pune in the evening.
